## **Lottery and Tours at Kincaid**


The Anchorage School District offers additional schools or programs outside the typical neighborhood school. The District utilizes a randomized lottery system to provide equal opportunity for all students who would like to participate in one of these alternative schools or programs. To participate in a school or program outside your child's neighborhood school, a lottery application must be submitted during the following application windows.

- February 1, 2025, at midnight Lottery opens for parents to submit applications.
- March 20, 2025, at 5pm Lottery closes for applications
- March 21, 2025 Lottery runs
- March 24-27, 2025 Schools validate accepted and wait lists
- March 28, 2025, at 5pm Parent notifications of Lottery results are released

Kincaid will be hosting school tours during the month of February every Tuesday from 8:30 am - 9:30 am. If you know a Kindergarten family who would like to join us, please let them know of this opportunity.

#### **Parent Pick-Up Tags**

#### **Visitors and Volunteers**
