Gruening MS Band Instrument-Specific Supply List

All students must have:

Instrument

Supplies to care for and maintain the instrument (see list, by instrument, below)
1" 3-ring binder w/ clear plastic sleeve for band use ONLY (not shared with other classes)
Pencil- we will have DAILY pencil checks! Pens are NOT acceptable.
Metronome & Tuner (free apps available for smart devices, and online)
Music stand (folding stand is fine)-- this stays at HOME for home practice.

Individual Instrument Supply Requirements

Some music stores may have these items packed together as a "starter pack". Supplies vary in price from \$15-60.

If you plan to rent a Gruening instrument, you MUST have your supplies before you are issued an instrument!

Note to Parents: Take this list with you to the music store, and when in doubt, show this to the staff– they can help you find the right equipment! SAVE YOUR RECEIPT, in case what you purchase is not what is needed.

<u>Flute</u> Swab rod Swab cloth, silk or cotton (NOT a polishing cloth!)


Clarinet/Bass Clarinet

Reeds- at least 3 good reeds (not cracked/chipped) at all times (Vandoren or Juno reeds ONLY) Reed case that holds at least 4 reeds Swab cloth (silk is recommended) Cork grease Mouthpiece brush

Oboe/Bassoon

Reeds- at least 2 good reeds (not cracked/chipped) at all times (Handmade reeds recommended; Jones reeds are OK but not great) Medicine bottle or film canister for water Swab cloth (silk) Cork grease

Saxophone Reeds- at least 3 reeds at all times (Vandoren or Juno reeds ONLY) Reed case that holds at least 4 reeds Neckstrap Swab cloth (silk is recommended) (Baritone Saxophone does not need a swab cloth) Cork grease Mouthpiece brush



Trumpet Valve oil Tuning slide grease Mouthpiece brush Wire snake (do NOT purchase a snake with plastic tubing-- it WILL break inside your instrument!) Intermediate/Advanced: Straight mute (white/red Stonelined, or metal– please no plastic straight mutes)

<u>French Horn</u>

Rotor valve oil Tuning slide grease Mouthpiece brush Wire snake (do NOT purchase a snake with plastic tubing-- it WILL break inside your instrument!)

Trombone

Small spray bottle Slide-o-Mix or Yamaha slide lubricant Cleaning rag (can literally be a rag) Tuning slide grease Mouthpiece brush Wire snake (do NOT purchase a snake with plastic tubing-- it WILL break inside your instrument!)

Euphonium/Baritone/Tuba

Valve oil Tuning slide grease Mouthpiece brush Wire snake (do NOT purchase a snake with plastic tubing-- it WILL break inside your instrument!)

Percussion

*Advanced Band percussionists must pay \$25 equipment rental fee to cover use of school percussion instruments. *Beginning & Intermediate Band students must provide your own percussion kit (bell kit & practice pad).

Stick bag- you must have a stick bag to hold your sticks and mallets.
Vic Firth SD-1 General sticks (no substitutes- get the SD-1 sticks!)
Mike Balter yarn mallets w/ rattan handles or equivalent
Musser hard rubber xylophone mallets or equivalent
Vic Firth T1 timpani mallets or equivalent
Jazz Band drummers must have lighter sticks for use with the drumset-- Vic Firth AJ1 or equivalent
