

### 100th and Victor Intersection Update

On December 17 the Anchorage Assembly voted in favor of a resolution addressing dangerous street crossing for school students. This makes our intersection another step closer to finding a solution to make it a more pedestrian friendly intersection.

Nov 17 Bayshore-Klatt Council meeting they agreed upon multiple suggestions the community were comfortable with those were: Flashing Beacon, Raised intersection, reducing the number of lanes or a single lane roundabout. This intersection does not qualify for a full signal light. MOA reported that this intersection has the same amount of traffic as it did in 2010.
