Last week, a team of educators from Mears Middle School and Dimond High School teamed up and headed to Anaheim, CA for the Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Summit. The team had a lot of fun and engaged in some really important work.

At the conference, the Mears/Dimond team worked together on strengthening the pathway from 7th and 8th grade to high school for those students taking any of the PLTW classes. At Mears, these classes include: Design and Modeling and Animation and Robotics. Participation in these classes prepare students well for Dimond's PLTW pathways in engineering, computer science and environmental science.

The strength of PLTW curriculum is that it focuses on essential skills for success in school, the work place, and life in general: Ethical Decision-making, Collaboration, Communication, Problem-solving, and Critical Thinking.


