
Session 1: June 2-30 and Session 2: July 12-August 6




Panthers are Readers Mears Reads Book Club

Ideas for writing an ekphrastic poem:

- 1. Write about the scene shown in the photo.
- Write about what happened just before or just after this scene...
- Write a conversation between the characters in the image.
- Write about your experience of looking at the photo or artwork.
- Write as a character in the photo or artwork speaking to the viewer.

ASD's planning and decision-making process for determining the District's risk level for conducting school takes multiple community factors into consideration. The District conducts this process in close conversation with the <u>Municipality of Anchorage</u> and the State of Alaska Department of Health and Social Services. In recent months, organizations such as the <u>Center for Disease Control</u>, the <u>American Academy of Pediatrics</u>, and the <u>World Health Organization</u> have expanded their guidance and resources regarding safely providing public education.
