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#### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

ASD Students must complete 22.5 credits to receive a high school diploma. Specific Polaris K-12 requirements can be found on the front of this page.

# English Language Arts (ELA): 4 credits

Eight semesters of ELA are required for graduation: three semesters of Composition, three semesters of Literature and two semesters of ELA Elective. These can be met by English I, II, III, and IV or their equivalents. At Polaris, students have the opportunity to take a wide variety of ELA courses not always offered in other settings.

## Social Studies: 4 credits

One semester of Alaska Studies, one semester of a Social Studies elective, two semesters of World History, two semesters of U.S. History, one semester of Economics, and one semester of United States Government. Students may waive the .5 credit social studies elective requirement by completion of Level III of a world language (ASL, Chinese, French, German, Japanese, Latin, Russian, or Spanish). Students may meet the World and/or U.S. History requirements by combining other semester-long social studies courses, with approval.

### Mathematics: 3 credits

Six semesters of Mathematics, to include one full year of Algebra. In order to satisfy the Algebra requirements, students must complete one of the following options: Algebra I, semesters 1 and 2 OR Survey of Algebra, semesters 1 and 2. After Algebra I students typically take: Geometry, Algebra II, AP Calculus, AP Statistics or other math electives.

## Sciences: 3 credits

Three years (six semesters) of science credit are required. Two semesters must be life science. Two semesters must be physical science. Two semesters may be any science course. Students typically take: Biology I, Chemistry I, and science electives of their choice.

## Physical Education/Health Education: 1.5 credits

Three semesters of physical/health education are required. A wide variety of courses are offered at Polaris K-12 School. Elective credit must be earned to replace a Physical Education/Health Education requirement that is waived. Students may obtain a K waiver of 0.25 of the physical education graduation requirement for each full season of ASAA-sanctioned sports participation within the Anchorage School District. Students may also waive comparable physical education requirements through Credit By Choice, correspondence, or college coursework in Physical Education/Health.

### **Electives: 7 credits**

Fourteen semesters: eight semesters (two credits) of Advisory are required for Polaris K-12. Other elective courses have not been specified in order to provide students an opportunity to pursue individual educational goals. Electives may include additional courses in Language Arts, Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, Technology, Fine Arts, World Languages, Physical Education and Career Technology.
