Students:

437 Students.

Travel club students were selected this last week to travel to Germany this May once school is out. It was a very competitive application process, and some fantastic students were unable to attend due to limited space. The travel club team will continue to finalize plans over the coming months.

Staffing:

All positions are filled besides ELL tutor, however, there are no applications at this time.

Curriculum and Instruction:

Rilke and ASD staff have been administering winter assessments to measure student academic growth from the beginning of the school year. We will be analyzing this data over the beginning of January to share with the staff to meet student needs. We are also working to improve student academic support through professional development and reviewing school schedules.

I would also like to begin a German curriculum review during the second semester. We have spent some time working as a German cohort to align instruction with DSD standards i.e. A1, A2, and B1 proficiency assessments. However, the next steps would be reviewing curriculum options. Ideally, we would move away from a Daf curriculum (German as a second language) and move towards a curriculum that German schools use. Furthermore, we would focus on foundational literacy, K-2 curriculum and build upon that over the next few years. However, we need to decide if we want to commit

funding. Based on my recent discussions, I think \$10,000 would be a good starting point, at least until we can do more research. I am not looking for a vote today, but want it to be on the radar in the board would like to pursue this curriculum review.

Budget:

The final draft of the budget has been developed. We will submit this version to ASD on December 15th, but we understand that ASD may require further adjustments through January.
