


Students:

480 Students

We finished up middle-of-the-year testing this week to monitor student academic progress. School wide, 73% of students scored in the top 60% which we consider proficient in math. Our school goal is 70%.



81% of students scored in the top 60% for reading. Our school goal is to hit 80%

Rilke Schule is coordinating with Dr. Wolfgang Leonhard and Dr. Bernd Nuss to conduct student research on second language German acquisition and comprehension. This group has been a part of our German Immersion School Team (GIST) which meets over zoom once a month to collaborate on a number of issues pertaining to German immersion schools. Additionally, this group has submitted their proposal to ASD and received approval to work with Rilke Schule. I am meeting with this team Wednesday morning to finalize plans and can provide more details after this meeting.

I am proposing that Rilke Schule hold full day parent - teacher conferences. Last month, I sent out a survey to receive feedback about extending parent-teacher conferences to a full day.
