Additionally, students completed winter assessments over the last couple of weeks in order to monitor academic progress. I plan to share results in January after we have some time to analyze and review the data. Initially, results look promising, but we will have more details next month.

Grade level teams met this week to go over student assessment data and form new intervention groups which will begin in January. So far, the interventions have resulted in desired student growth.

Herr Jones, the school counselor, is leading in house professional development beginning in January using the book, Conscious Discipline. The goal is to provide staff with methodologies that promote classroom management and positive discipline with students.

We are beginning to plan for our 24-25 school year German interns through the Amity program. This process begins by considering how many intern positions to open and revising their educational plans for the next school year.

An "intention to return" survey has been sent out to staff so we may begin planning for next school year. The hiring process in ASD begins at the end of February.
