

Principal's Report

Enrollment:

436 Students. This number is down from enrollment numbers prior to the covid epidemic. A reasonable goal would be to increase enrollment by 5% each year over a two year span. Ideally, enrollment will approach 500 students after the two years.

Staffing:

Most positions are filled. We still have an opening for an ELL tutor which I am following up with. Furthermore, I would like to examine the budget to see if we can hire another SPED tutor. However, we could use more subs. With that being said, I want to thank the community for responding to our call for subs, we have had several interested parties that we are working with.

Curriculum:

Teachers have begun to implement the new math curriculum, Ready Mathematics. They received training at the district in-service day. As a year long project, we will examine the scope and sequence of the German curriculum to ensure rigor and appropriate scaffolding.

Communication:

I will be using a weekly newsletter, emails, and Facebook as the primary means of communication. Moreover, teachers will be communicating class news and information on a regular basis over the school year.
