- The goal is for all students to score above the 40th percentile in reading and math.
- o If your student's score is below the 40th percentile, we need to work together to help them catch



- O Attendance is a key to student success. Thank you for having your student at school, on time, every day. If your student has missed more than 10% of school, you will receive an attendance report on bright paper. It will be stapled to your student's reading and math scores.


There are no Healthy Futures logs in December or January.
