



## Reminder: Free & Reduced-Price Meal Applications Available Year-Round

Did you know you can apply for free and reduced-price school meals at any time during the school year? If your financial situation has changed—due to job loss, reduced work hours, or changes in household size—you may apply or reapply, even if you've already submitted an application for the 2024-2025 school year.

□. Apply online anytime at <u>https://www.schoolcafe.com/anchorage</u>.
Who Should Apply?

✓ Families with at least one student attending a pricing school (a school that charges for meals) should list all ASD students and household members—including those receiving a Permanent Fund

Dividend—along with income details and frequency.

✓ Households receiving SNAP or TANF benefits can apply using a case number and a copy of the Free Meal/Direct Certification document from Public Assistance.

✓ Foster parents should submit documentation showing the child is a ward of the state of Alaska or a Tribal entity.

# **Parking Lot Safety**

Safety for our students is our number one priority.

If you are picking up or dropping students off, please stay in your vehicle when going through the car line. If you need to get out of your car, please park, and walk up to our parent waiting zone to pick up your child(ren).

For everyone's safety, please use the crosswalk when crossing the street if you are parked down the block. **Avoid** walking in the bus zone, as it can be dangerous and drivers may not be able to see you around the buses. Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe!

For the safety and smooth operation of our school, please note that students should **not** be dropped off or parked at the ice rink side of the school. All students must be dropped off and picked up at the **front pick-up/drop-off zone**. This policy helps ensure the safety of all students and prevents disruption to the flow of buses departing the school.

A quick reminder: for safety reasons, students **cannot** be dropped off **before 8:40am on Mondays** and **before 7:40am on Tuesday-Friday** due to low staffing. We ask that you **not have your child** 

**wait outside until those times**, as staff are not yet available to supervise students. Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe.

Also, please stay off phones while driving in the parking lot at Taku during pick up and drop off.

#### Important Update: New Pick-Up Change Policy

We will no longer be able to accommodate pick-up changes after 2:15pm, except in the case of an emergency. Late changes create unnecessary confusion in the office, as we need to locate students, verify bus routes, and ensure timely dismissals. We also want to avoid delays for students on the buses.
