## BICYCLES, SCOOTERS & BOARDS AT GRUENING MIDDLE SCHOOL

Students who ride/bring bicycles, scooters & boards to school are required to have a signed permission form on file with security. This form must be signed and returned to the GMS Attendance Office. All riders MUST wear helmets. Reflective lights on bikes and reflective tape on clothing is recommended for safety reasons. Bikes should be walked & scooters and boards carried when near the school entrance, parked in the racks provided, or locked in school locker, and securely locked at all times. Students who elect to ride their bike, scooter or board to school should do the following:

- 1. All riders MUST wear protective helmets as required by law on any MUNI roads, streets or bike path. Penalty for violation of the helmet law is \$25.
- 2. Be familiar with laws and safety rules for proper bike operation.

  Students must obey all road signs and traffic signals. Bike riders should completely dismount their bikes and walk the across intersections in heavy traffic. Riders should always ride single file on the side of the road with the flow of traffic and use a bike path whenever one is available.
- 3. Upon entering school grounds, take your ride directly to a bike rack and securely lock it to the rack.
- 4. Rides MUST BE equipped with locks to prevent theft or unauthorized borrowing.
- 5. To prevent accidents or other problems, please walk or carry your ride once close to the building.
- 6. Bicycles, scooters or boards are not to be left on campus overnight or on weekends, past history indicates that they are subject to vandalism and/or theft.
- 7. Double riding is NEVER allowed.
