# KINCAID CAFETERIA AND SCHOOL LUNCHES

I am writing to inform you that our school will start this school year without a cafeteria manager. Please know that the Anchorage School District is actively addressing this matter.

The impact of not having a trained cafeteria manager is that our school will not be able to serve heated meals to students until this situation is corrected. Please know schools participating in the USDA National School Lunch Program will continue to have school lunches available at no cost to all students through the end of the 2021-2022 school year. I want to assure you that your student(s) will be able to obtain shelf-stable lunches at school and that these meals will meet all USDA nutritional requirements.

Additionally, due to the limited menu options and staff shortage, we will not be able to accommodate special dietary requests. Ingredients will be listed online. If your student has an allergy to any ingredients in the meal, please consider having your student bring lunch from home.

While this is certainly not the condition we want to be in going into the academic year, we are absolutely committed to our students' well-being. The District is making every effort to fill Student Nutrition vacancies, including offering a pay incentive up to \$2,500 for community members who hire on with our Student Nutrition Department and successfully complete a probationary period.

I'd like ask our community to sign on to be a cafeteria hero! Do you or someone you know have the availability to join our Student Nutrition staff and make a difference in the lives of your children, grandchildren and community members? We need your time and talents to build a strong community. ASD offers competitive salaries, convenient work schedules, PERS retirement, leave, holiday pay and more.

#### **BEGINNNG OF DAY**

**8:40-8:50** Student Drop Off (BEST time to drop off to avoid late arrival or tardies)

**8:50-9:00** Students are invited into class to put their things away, get indoor shoes on, get settled and ready for school.

**9:00** Learning Begins. Students will be late if they enter school at this time, and could miss instruction in reading, math, or a specialist class. *The best time to drop off your child is between 8:40 and 8:50.*

We will stagger dismissal at the end of the day to avoid too much congestion in our parent pick-up line. This worked very well last year, and we decided to keep it in place for this year. If you are picking up a 4th, 5th or 6th grade student, please do not be in the front of our parent pick-up line.

### STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Students must be dropped off or picked up next to the Clock Tower. The drop off/pick up lane is only accessible from the Rasberry Entry. Parents who choose to park can accesss the parking lot from both the Rasberry and Caravelle Entries. Students may not be dropped off in the parking lot. They must be escorted by an adult to the clock tower. Students may not be picked up in the parking lot. Parents must greet their child at their grade level cone near the clock tower.

Parents/Guardians may opt to drive and drop along the curb. If so, students must exit the car on the curb side.

Before School--It is important to drop your child off between 8:40-8:50. Students come inside at 8:50 and have a few minutes to get their things put away and get settled before school begins, promptly at 9:00 am. Students who arrive after 8:50 often feel rushed or late. To make for a successful start to your child's day, please make sure they are here by 8:50 am.
