Thank you Kincaid community for your participation in our Open House last week. It was so great seeing our families back inside the building once again. RETURN TO SCHOOL FOLLOWING AN ILLNESS

So far our families have really done a terrific job keeping our school open for teaching and learning. If your child is sick, you have a few options to follow. The graphic below explains your options.

Return to School Options

For Anyone with COVID-19 Symptoms or a Positive COVID-19 Test Result:

1

If you test positive, stay home for 10 days after your first symptom or positive test, whichever is earlier. After 10 days, you may return to school when you have not had a fever in 24 hours without fever reducing medicine, as long as your other symptoms are improving.

2

If you test negative, you may return to school once you have not had a fever in 24 hours without fever reducing medicine as long as your other symptoms are improving.

3

If you do not get a test, stay home for 10 days. You may return after 10 days if you have not had a fever in 24 hours without fever reducing medicine as long as your other symptoms are improving.

4

If your healthcare provider determines your symptoms are from something else, you may return to school with a note from your provider as long as you have not had a fever in 24 hours without fever reducing medicine and your other symptoms are improving.





SAFETY DRILLS AT KINCAID

Each year we practice several drills to help our students and staff be prepared for an actual emergency. We have an Emergency Action Plan in place at Kincaid Elementary. Part of the plan is to practice six drills during the course of the year.

- Evacuation/Fire Drill
- Drop, Cover and Hold/ Earthquake Drill
- Stay Put Drill
- Lockdown Drill
- ALICE Drill (See attached flier for details)
- Shelter in Place

During the month of September we will practice several of the above drills. On **September 15** this year, we expect to practice a Stay Put, Lockdown, and ALICE drill. Students will evacuate the building to a rally point outside of the building.
