BACK TO SCHOOL

Dear Kincaid Families,

Thank you for being patient with us during construction. Our office is still working out of the libarary as crews continue to complete many projects. Our hallway floors are finished along with a few classroom floors! Our office has counters, new carpet and new doors! Next week we hope to get furniture and cabinets installed. I appreciate the crews that have been working long days and weekends to get these projects complete.



We are so excited to welcome you back to school for the 2023/24 school year! We look forward to seeing all of our students and their families on **Wednesday, August 16th between 4:30-5:30 for Popsicles on the Playground and Meet Your Teacher Night.** Class lists will be posted on the brick wall on the playground and also by the front doors to our school. Thank you to our PTA for providing the popsicles!

We have great news! We have a cafeteria manager assigned to Kincaid this year! This means our students will have a hot lunch program! Our new manager is receiving extensive training so our hot food service will begin on September 8th. We are pleased to welcome Traci Gimarc as our new cafeteria manager. Shelf stable meals will be served between August 17 and September 7.

We are also pleased to announce that ASD Student Nutrition is excited to provide our **Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program** (FFVP) at Kincaid Elementary. Our program will operate twice a week, on Tuesdays and Thursdays, and will begin on September 5th.

As you know, we have some exciting new things happening this year. Grades K-3 will be using a new reading curriclum entitled Core Knowledge Language Arts, or CKLA. This program is tied closely with the Science of Reading and will help to equip our young readers with reading skills for life! Next year (2024-2025), grades 4 and 5 will transition to the new program. PLC Mondays passed with the school board in May of 2023. This means that every Monday, school will begin at 10:00 starting fall 2023. (Student drop off will begin at 9:40 on MONDAYS. It will remain 8:40 with a 9:00 start the rest of the week.) Teachers and staff will be able to engage in meaningful collaboration to support our Professional Learning Community around our reading, math and behavior goals. PARENT DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Students should exit the vehicle on the curb side only. We have signs designating where parent pick-up and drop-off off begins and ends. We ask that you pull as far forward as you can, closing all gaps in the line. Our staff will help guide you. They are out there to keep our students and visitors safe.

Students may not be dropped off in the parking lot to walk alone. If you do park in the parking lot, we ask that students are escorted safely through the cross-walk to the sidewalk area.

At the end of the day, students will wait by their grade level cone for parents. If you are in the parent pick-up line, they will be excused as soon as we see you. If you are in the parking lot, you must walk to the cones to pick your child up.



If you choose to park in our parking lot, you MUST walk your child across the <u>cross</u> walk.

Students may not be dropped off in our lot without an adult walking them safely to the sidewalk.
