BUS RIDERS

PARENT PICK-UP AND DROP OFF

- Place sign with child's name and grade and teacher on the dash. (signs were sent home with students but you may also make your own)
- No Cell Phone Usage in our pick-up line by drivers.
- Always **pull forward** and fill the gaps so that many students may load at once.
- **5 MPR** is the speed limit (It is very slow to keep students, staff and visitors safe).
- Students MUST **load and unload on the curb side** only. Students must be escorted to the sidewalk in the moring if you park in the parking lot. The parking lot is not a drop-off zone.
- Students are not allowed to go to the parking area to load without an adult escorting.
- Everyone MUST **use the cross walk** to get to and from the parking lot. Please do not walk between cars or other non-designated areas.

Important Drop Off and Pick Up Reminders



Riding the school bus is a privilege. Students must follow the bus rules in order to continue the privilege. Please review these expectations with your child if your child rides the school bus.

- Must always stay seated while the bus is moving.
- Follow the bus drivers instructions.
- May NOT eat, drink, or chew gum on the bus.
- Phones are stored in backpacks unless the bus is late and student is communicating with a parent via phone or text.
- Phones are not used for entertainment on the bus.
- Use a soft spoken voice to talk quietly to people in the same seat.

CELL PHONES AT SCHOOL AND ON THE SCHOOL BUS

All cell phones must be turned off and stored in student backpacks during the school day. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen phones. Phones that are used during the school day without direct teacher permission will be turned into the front office for parents to pick up.



Students who ride the school bus are required to keep phones stored in their backpack during the ride home. Phones may not be used for entertainment on the bus. Students have permission to call or text parents if the bus is running late.
