## Principal's Message

Dear Kincaid Families,

We are excited to invite every parent/guardian to school to meet with your child's teacher later this month. Please sign up on the <u>Conference Scheduler</u> soon to secure your time. Parent/Teacher conferences are an excellent time to share information about your child and to learn about how your child is progressing at school. Expect to hear about student performance and behavior. Teachers will be sharing assessment data and progress monitoring data. In this Coyote Howler I am including videos and information about reading. Teachers will be discussing progress/non-progression with parents if your child has scored far below benchmark in reading during Winter Assessments.

We also know that attendance is a factor in student performance. At Kincaid, only 58% of our students attend school 90% of the time or better. This means that 42% of our students miss more than 10% of their school days. Children are considered chronically absent with more than 10% absences each semester. We are asking for all parents to help increase our attendance performance. When students are here, they receive instruction, interventions, and support from our school staff. Strive to be at school every day by 8:45 am. Do you know your child's attendance rate? 





Teaching students to read with proficiency by the end of the third grade is a very important goal in the elementary schools in the Anchorage School District. In order for children to understand what they read, they must learn about the sounds in words and the meaning of words. They must learn to read with fluency.

Here are ways parents can help in this important work!

- Read aloud to your child every day.
- Let your child see you read and let your child know that you enjoy reading.
- Be involved in your child's reading progress. Ask your child's teacher what you can do to help your child.
- Surround your child with books and other reading material.
- Limit television. Show your child that reading, writing, drawing and playing games together are even more fun than television.
   Carefully choose the shows your child does watch. Watch and discuss programs together.

When your child learns to read, listen to him/her read for a few minutes every day. The more a child reads, the better reader he/she becomes.

Every single time a child reads something, he/she is changed by it.




