Yesterday during a briefing on State Health, Governor Dunleavy announced that school closures were to be extended through the end of the school year. Though the decision did not come as a surprise to many given the ongoing threat of the Covid-19 pandemic, it does come with a tremendous amount of disappointment and sorrow. All of us at Mears and throughout ASD are deeply saddened at the thought of not being able to see our students at school again this year.

That said, we remain committed to ensuring the health and safety of young people throughout Anchorage and we are pleased to be able to engage with our students on a daily basis in an online educational setting. 


District Health Services




Mears PTSA Leadership Positions Available
