Weekly Update From Susitna

PRINCIPAL UPDATE

Hello and welcome to another week of online learning! Teachers are enjoying the interaction with the Susitna families and students. Thank you for helping your kids continue to learn through this time of uncertainty. ASD is working hard during this transition to on-line learning to keep students safe. Your child's ASD Personally Identifiable Information (PII) is carefully protected from others, and your young students are being carefully protected from websites and apps that are not appropriate for them (including YouTube). There are many other things ASD is doing - please read below to learn more about them!

Is my child safe online?

With much of our learning going online, it is a great time to review cyber safety guidelines with your children. There are three important things to consider for your family's cyber safety: the technology you use, your household rules, and how you will be monitoring student usage. ASD has created a <u>Safe Computing webpage</u> that addresses these three areas in more detail. It also has a host of resources to help you ensure your child's online safety.

Is my child safe on Zoom?

You may have read in the news that there are concerns about the safety of Zoom. ASD has put many pieces in place with Zoom to keep our students safe and we believe we are a part of a good learning system. We use passwords and small groups so we know who is live with us. We have eliminated private chat between students. We require that students enter our live sessions with a known student name, and teachers let each student into the live session after looking at those names.

What online safety precautions has ASD put into place?

The District's <u>Safe Computing webpage</u> includes many <u>best practices for making your child</u> <u>safe at home</u>. The District has also implemented a number of measures to help keep kids safe while doing online work:

- · Online sharing across District applications is limited to other students and staff.
- \cdot ASD Chromebook devices have content filtering enabled.
- ASD Chromebook devices run the Chrome operating system, which updates regularly and has fewer software risks.
- \cdot ASD devices and accounts are monitored for hacking and malware.
