AK Reads Act Updates - Progression vs Non-Progression

Part of the Alaska Reads Act is identifying students who are 'well below' and who might need additional time and support to catch up.

Alaska Reads Act Requirements



Students in grades K-3rd who show that are in the well below category for the assessment, will be considered for nonprogression or more commonly known as retention. This conversation will be introduced to families at February conferences. The conversation will include parents/guardians, teacher and principal. The family will make the final decision on whether or not their child will progress to the next grade level. The state is requiring districts to have families of 3rd grade students who are well below, sign a waiver with their decision around
