


Panthers are Readers Mears Reads Book Club

Ekphrastic poems usually refer to poems that describe a work of art. In Ancient Greece, the term referred to the skill of describing an object in vivid detail.







For this contest, select a photo that catches your eye. The photo could be of anything: people, places, events, artwork, nature. Make <u>it</u> the subject of your poem.

Ideas for writing an ekphrastic poem:

- 1. Write about the scene shown in the photo.
- Write about what happened just before or just after this scene...
- Write a conversation between the characters in the image.
- Write about your experience of looking at the photo or artwork.
- Write as a character in the photo or artwork speaking to the viewer.

- Poems should be no more than 20 lines.
- Deadline for April submissions is Friday, April 30th.
- Submit your poem and the picture on which you based your poem as a text entry inside the Canvas panther pictures course.

ASD's planning and decision-making process for determining the District's risk level for conducting school takes multiple community factors into consideration. The District conducts this process in close conversation with the <u>Municipality of Anchorage</u> and the State of Alaska Department of Health and Social Services. In recent months, organizations such as the <u>Center for Disease Control</u>, the <u>American Academy of Pediatrics</u>, and the <u>World Health Organization</u> have expanded their guidance and resources regarding safely providing public education.


