If possible:

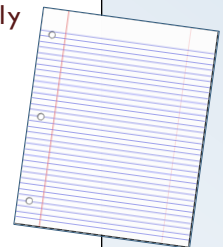
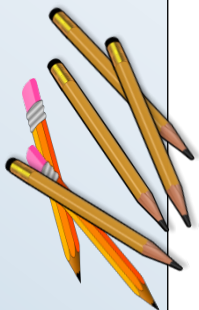
- ☐ \$5 for cooking supplies

The following items are also included on the general upper elementary supply list and are also needed:
