- Schedule changes are officially over. Please remind your student that they must remain in their current classes until the end of the first semester.

## College/Career

- Now is the time for Seniors to be narrowing their list of colleges/universities/trade schools that
  they want to apply to for next year. College bound students should consider starting their Common
  Application.
- South High will administer the ASVAB test on September 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:30am. Students can sign up with Mrs. Roberts at the curriculum office.
- South High is hosting a College Planning Night on September 21, 6-7pm. This is geared towards 11-12th grade students and parents. Frontier Tutoring will be presenting helpful information on this important process. Students/Parents will need to pre-register for the College Planning Night through Frontier Tutoring. Link to sign up forthcoming.
- The **PSAT** will be offered to SAHS **Juniors only** on Saturday, **October 16**. Counselors will visit all Junior English classes on October 1 to inform students about the PSAT and how to sign up. Sign up and payment runs October 4-14. Students must pay for the PSAT through Parent Connect during the sign-up window. There are a limited number of spots for the PSAT and tests will be awarded on a first come, first serve, basis.

### **Counseling Notes**

• Seniors! If you want your counselor or teacher to write you a letter of recommendation for any college application, you must personally ask them (via email, telephone, or in person). An electronic invitation sent from Common App., SEND EDU, etc., is not sufficient. Give your counselor/teacher at least 2 weeks to complete the letter.
