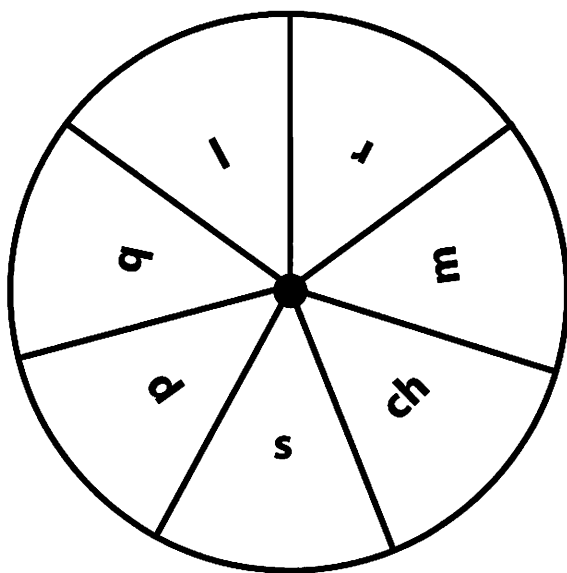

Use paper fasteners and paper clips to make two spinners. Spin them both and use the letters to make words below. If the letters don't make a word, spin again.

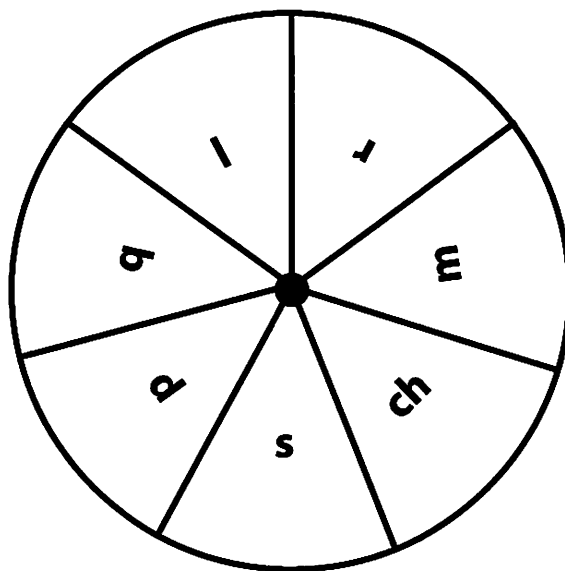
Make Spinners

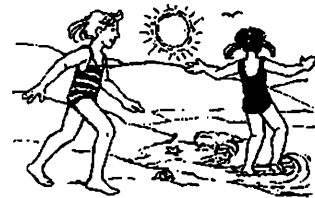
