Online registration for the 2023-24 school year opened for returning students on April 24th. New to District students can do pre-enrollment starting July 15th. We want to continue to recognize those students who have sought out adult help when they've seen something this year that concerned them online or during face to face instruction. ASD has a catchy phrase that we use in these situations. **If you see something, say something!** This applies to any situation where someone is being unsafe. Thanks for talking with your children about getting help and knowing that when safety is involved, it's the right action to take.

I also want to highlight the need to supervise your children on the Gladys Wood playground after school hours. We've had a number of alarming activities that have occurred in the evenings and weekends when there is no adult around. Even if your children are in 6th grade, it's a good idea to plan to be with them. Our playground becomes a municipality park after hours starting at 4pm and anyone is able to come and go from it including much older students and young adults.

Thank you also for dropping your children off between 8:40am-8:45am and picking up at 3:30pm. We start supervising the grounds at 8:40am.

The Straw family wants you to know we continue to keep all of the Gladys Wood community in our thoughts and prayers over the summer and are thankful to be a part of your school family!

In preparation for next school year, please remember that all Care Plans (Asthma, Allergy, Diabetes, Seizure...), and Medication Forms, <u>MUST</u> be renewed/updated and turned back in at the start of every school year.

The <u>NEW Fairweather Childhood Vaccination Clinic</u> is open at 1130 N Muldoon, Suite 110 (in the Tikahtnu Commons shopping plaza next to the Pita Pit restaurant). **This clinic is open to the public, free of charge, 7 days a week from 9am to 5pm.** Take advantage of this free resource to get your and your children's vaccinations up to date.
